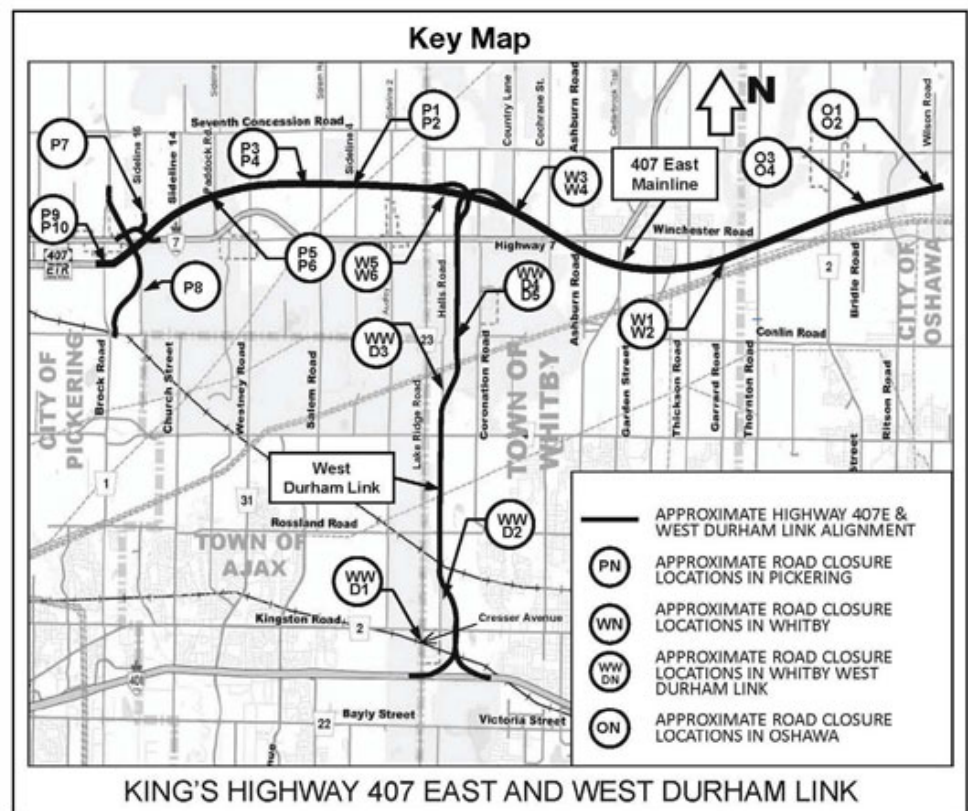
### NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSINGS

#### Highway 407 East (Phase 1)

The **Ministry of Transportation (MTO)** plans to build King's Highway 407 East and the West Durham Link, from approximately Brock Road in the City of Pickering (Geographic Township of Pickering) through the Town of Whitby (Geographic Township of Whitby) to Harmony Road in the City of Oshawa (Geographic Township of East Whitby), Regional Municipality of Durham. As part of this work, some of the roads that intersect the Highway 407 East right-of-way will be closed. On November 25, 2011, as a result of an application by the MTO, a public hearing of the Ontario Municipal Board was held to consider certain road closings. On December 7, 2011, the Ontario Municipal Board approved the closing of 13 roads in the Geographic Region of Durham where they intersect the Highway 407 East right-of-way.

The road closings, located within the City of Pickering, the Town of Whitby, and the City of Oshawa, all within the Regional Municipality of Durham, are listed below and shown on the key map. The plan reference numbers are: P-5054-0130 in the City of Pickering; P-5120-0229 and P-5120-0233 in the Town of Whitby; and P-5119-0059 in the City of Oshawa.

- Brock Road (North and South of 407 East) in Durham (**P9 and P10**)
- Sideline 16 (North and South of 407 East) in Pickering (**P7 and P8**)
- Paddock Road (North and South of 407 East) in Pickering (**P5 and P6**)
- Road Allowance between Lots 8 & 9 in Pickering (**P3 and P4**)
- Sideline 4 (North and South of 407 East) in Pickering (**P1 and P2**)
- Halls Road (North of Taunton Road and South of Rossland Road) in Whitby (**WWD2 and WWD3**)
- Garrard Road (North and South of 407 East) in Whitby (**W1 and W2**)
- Halls Road (North and South of 407 East) in Whitby (**W5 and W6**)
- Country Lane (North and South of 407 East) in Whitby (**W3 and W4**)
- Cresser Avenue (in Almond Village) in Whitby (**WWD1**)
- Road Allowance (between Concessions 4 & 5 East of Halls Road) in Whitby (**WWD4 and WWD5**)
- Wilson Road (North and South of 407 East) in Oshawa (**O1 and O2**)
- Road Allowance (between Lots 10 and 11, Concession 6, East of Simcoe Street) in Oshawa (**O3 and O4**)



Claims for compensation for injurious affection (reduction in market value of lands or personal and business damages caused by the road closings) must be made within one year of the physical closing of the road, or the right to compensation is lost, as per Section 22 of the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.26.
